

A Note About Your Sunflower Potatoes ☐

Thank you for your order of 8 plants!

Here's what you're receiving today:

- **4 smaller plants** – well-rooted and ready to go straight into the ground in full sun.
- **4 larger plants** – freshly lifted and potted. Because their roots were disturbed, they may look a little droopy at first. This is normal transplant shock.
- **+ 1 bonus large plant** – included at no charge, with well-developed tubers, to make up for the fact that I ran out of potted ones.

For the larger plants:

- Keep in shade or dappled light for about a week while they settle.
- Water regularly so the soil stays moist (not soggy).
- Don't worry if they don't push new top growth this fall — it's September, so the energy will stay in the tubers and they'll sprout strong new shoots next spring.

So in total you'll have **9 plants (4 small + 5 large)**. Even if the big ones sulk a little now, they'll overwinter just fine and give you a great patch next year.
